Bible Study Notes

Key Definitions:

- Eschatology: the study of end times from a religious perspective or point of view
- Dispensations: a division of biblical history; "the age of"
- Millennial Kingdom: 1000 year reign of Jesus; a time of universal peace on earth
- Rapture: catch up, suddenly take away; Jesus will come to earth and remove His people (1 Thessalonians 4:16-18)
- Great Tribulation: a 7 year period of persecution (3 ½ years from Antichrist and 3 ½ years from God)

Dispensations (the age of):

- 1. Innocence: from Gen 1:28 Gen 2:15-17
- 2. Conscience: Gen 3:8 8:22 (approximately 1650 years from the Garden to the Flood)
- 3. Human Government: Gen 8 call of Abraham
- 4. Promise: Abraham Exodus from Egypt (430 years)
- 5. Law: Exodus death of Jesus
- 6. Grace: Jesus' resurrection Now
- 7. Millennial Kingdom: Rev 20 Final Judgment

Main End Time Theologies or Viewpoints:

- > <u>Premillennial</u>: end time events including the Tribulation and the Rapture come before the second coming of Christ and His 1000 year reign; Historic and Dispensational (most common view)
 - o <u>Pre-Tribulation (pre-trib)</u>: the rapture of Christians occurs before the Tribulation period and the rise of Antichrist
 - Mid-Tribulation (mid-trib): the rapture of Christians occurs halfway through the Tribulation period (3 ½ years)
 - o Post-Tribulation (post-trib): the rapture of Christians occurs at the end of the Tribulation period (7 years)
- > Postmillennial: a time when Christianity would spread and the church would rule the world, prior to Jesus' second coming (no longer in favor)
- > Amillennial: there is no actual 1000 year reign of Jesus; "the church" has replaced the Jews as God's "chosen people"
